Custom Job Purpose:

This position exists to perform responsible supervisory work operating various size school cafeterias.

Essential Functions of this Job

Extensive knowledge of the planning, preparation and service of a large variety of foods. Considerable knowledge of foodservice equipment. Considerable knowledge of food values in nutrition. Considerable knowledge of health, sanitary, and safety practices in the foodservice operation. Considerable knowledge of accountability and claiming procedures related to federally funded child nutrition programs. A considerable knowledge of storage of food and non-food supplies. Ability to supervise the operation of economical, nutritious, and effective meals. Ability to supervise and train foodservice personnel. Ability establish and maintain effective working relationships with employees, students and school personnel. Demonstrates appropriate written and verbal communication skills. Ability to provide a high level of customer service to parents and other community members.

Non-Essential Functions of this Job

Performs other duties as assigned.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

One year experience in school foodservice or related work. Completion of all required school foodservice courses, and other requirements as established by departmental regulations. Bilingual/biliterate preferred.

Education, Experience and/or Certification/License Requirements

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Graduation from an accredited high school or completion of GED.

Work Context:

Requires standing, walking and moving about to coordinate work. Requires face-to-face discussions and contact with individuals and/or teams. Requires coordination of work tasks to establish priorities, set goals and meet deadlines.

Physical Environment:

Requires standing for the majority of the day, and the ability to frequently lift, carry, move and/or position objects weighing up to 20 pounds, and infrequently weighing between 20 and 50 pounds. Requires working indoors in environmentally controlled conditions. Requires the proper use of personal protective devices and equipment as assigned.
