

## Preschool Programs Teacher-PK



To be a PK teacher in Title 1 or Head Start, the candidate must be FL DOE certified *and* FL DCF credentialed.

## Florida DOE Certification Requirements

- Current, professional teaching certificate (BA or higher)
  - o PK Primary Certification
  - o Related fields will be reviewed individually

All Department of Education (DOE) requirements must be completed prior to hire.

## Florida DCF Child Care Credentialing / Training Transcript:

- Staff Credential Verification must reflect eligibility to teach Voluntary PreKindergarten (VPK)
- Training Transcript: Emergent Literacy for VPK Instructors (5-hour, online course, \$10)
- Training Transcript: Florida Standards for Four-Year-Olds (3-hour, online course, \$10)
